

November 26, 1936.

The meeting was called to order by the pastor, and Mr. Lentz led in the opening prayer. The minutes were read and approved.

A report was called for on our representation at the Memphis Young People's Conference; and it was reported that the delegates had been selected -- Alline Porter and Gerald Cooper -- but that the money had not yet been gotten. This matter was left up to the general superintendent to look after.

Two teachers were elected at this time: Mr. John Woodward for the Intermediate Department, and Miss Jones for the Nursery Department.

The question of the program for the Christmas season was then taken up. The pastor reported that it had already been arranged for the Young People's Department to give a Christmas play at the church service on Sunday night, December 15. After some discussion it was decided to have a Christmas Family Night on December 22 for the white gift service. A committee composed of Prof. Godard, Mrs. Allison, Mr. Allen, and Mr. Smith was appointed to work out the details.

Some discussion was held concerning courses for the Young People's Department for the next quarter, with a consideration for regrouping and using the same courses as have been offered the past quarter. Prof. Wilson agreed to take it up with the young people themselves and see what could be best arranged.

The possibility of holding a Church Night at least occasionally was again brought to the front, and it was suggested that we try to work out something of the kind during the month of January. It was decided to take the matter up with the Board of Stewards and the Adult Division, and a committee composed of Prof. Wilson, Mr. Lentz, and the pastor was appointed to try to
