

April 14, 1936.

The meeting was called to order by the chairman and the minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Ranson reported for the committee on Church School Day, that the program was in the hands of all departments and that everything was under way for the presentation. After some discussion it was decided to hold the service at 9:45, instead of later, in order to be through and to give way for the Trinity Methodist Church Anniversary Program at 11 O'clock, to which they had invited the members of our church.

Prof. Wilson reported for the Boy Scout work. The Scout Circus mentioned at the last meeting had to be postponed because of the bad weather, but it was finally held very successfully in Raleigh. Practically the whole membership of our troop attended, and a very creditable performance was given. Prof. Wilson said he felt that scouting in Durham was at the best stage it had ever been, and that the troop here was getting along very well. The suggestion was made that the Scout work should be presented to the whole church school in the Church School Day program, and Prof. Wilson and Helen Card were asked to arrange for such a presentation.

Mr. Allen reported that the Elementary departments were getting along very nicely, with the possible exception of the Beginners' Department which needed some more help. It was suggested that Mrs. Abernethy might be available for help again, and the superintendent of the department and of the division were asked to try to see about getting her to come back.

Special mention was made of the new piano given to the



Nursery Department by Mrs. J.C. Angier, and the secretary was asked to write her a note of thanks for it. A note of thanks to Mrs. Spence for the help of her class and herself in the carrying on of the work of the Nursery Department was also authorized, to carry with it the invitation of the Board for Mrs. Spence to be the Assistant Superintendent of the Children's Division. The Church Hour Nursery was especially mentioned, and attention called to its help for parents who wish to attend the church services and may leave their children during the time.

A report for some specific plans about sending some representatives from our church school to Lake Junaluska for the Leadership Schools next summer was left in the hands of Russell Ranson and Reba Cousins, the report to be made at the next meeting of this board.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
