




The Board of Christian Education of Duke Memorial Church held a meeting in the Pastor's Study on Monday, December 14, at 7:00 p.m., the Chairman, Dr. A. M. Proctor, presiding. Following the prayer by Mr. Lentz, the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The General Superintendent recommended the following changes in the teaching staff which were unanimously approved by the Board: N. J. Boddie to replace J. H. Coman as teacher for the second year boys in the Intermediate Department; Mrs. W. O. Thompson to replace Mrs. W. J. Eiteman in the Beginners Department.

Following up the matter of the proposed recreation room for the Church, Mr. Lentz, speaking in behalf of the committee appointed to act for the Board, said that the change involved in the meeting places of the departments was satisfactory to the Nursery and Beginners Departments. Dr. Proctor then reported that representatives of the Young People's Division appeared before the Board of Stewards at its last meeting. At that time they were authorized to secure estimates on the cost of remodeling the room and present these estimates to the Board at its next meeting.

Mr. Lentz, reporting on the status of the Church School in general, stated that the average attendance for the past quarter had been about 380 out of an enrollment of 656. He also called attention to the fact that the Sunday collections had fallen off, this being due principally to the decrease in attendance. Out of these collections that of the fourth Sunday goes to the Conference collection and the fifth Sunday to the Orphanage, the balance being used almost entirely for the Church School literature. Consequently, there was little left for other activities in connection with the various departments. On motion of Mr. Stewart, duly seconded and passed by the Board, it was decided ^{that Mr. Lentz would} to ask the Board of Stewards to appropriate in its annual budget a sum of \$200 for the use of the Church School. Mr. Lentz was requested to consult with the departmental





superintendents and make a specific statement as to what the appropriation would be used for at the next meeting of the Board of Christian Education.

The Chairman called attention to the fact that March 28 was the date set for the city-wide leadership school.

On motion of Mr. Lentz, the Board voted to hold monthly meetings on the first Monday after the first Sunday, the next being on January 4.

The Board adjourned to attend the meeting of the Workers' Council.
