## Minutes of Workers' Council Meeting, Duke Memorial Church

The Workers' Council of Duke Memorial Church held a dinner meeting in the basement of the church on Monday, November 27, at 6:30 p.m., Mr. W. E. Whitford, General Superintendent, presiding. Just prior to the dinner Dr. Glenn led the devotional and outlined briefly the five objectives of the "Crusade for Christ."

Following the dinner the officers and teachers of the Church School were introduced to the Council by the general and departmental superintendents.

Mrs. Gates presented to the Council the Principles and Objectives of the new Church School year as passed by the Board of Christian Education, which met earlier in the evening. Various points of the plan were discussed by members of the Council, Mrs. C. W. Peppler, Miss Alice Fleming, and Mr. E. L. Haywood. On motion by Dr. Proctor, duly seconded, the program as outlined was adopted by those present. The same committee which prepared the Principles and Objectives drew up a Covenant, to which those present, as active members of the Church School, were asked to pledge themselves. On motion by Dr. Holton, duly seconded, the members of the Council agreed to sign this.

The matter of the Christmas program for the approaching season was presented by Dr. Proctor. Because of the difficulty in getting food and because the orphanage preferred having money, the White Christmas program, usually held each year, was omitted last year. The question put to the Council was whether or not the special seasonal program should be resumed this year, and, if so, when it should take place. After much discussion, Dr. Proctor made the motion that a Christmas program be presented, preferably on the evening of Sunday, December 17, that the Council confirm this opinion, that notice of the action be passed on to the Board of Stewards, and that, subject to the approval of the Council, the Superintendent of the Church School appoint a committee to work out the details of such a program. The motion was carried.

The meeting was dismissed with prayer by Mrs. Gates.
