

May 29, 1945.

The Duke Memorial Board of Christian Education met Tuesday, May 29, 1945, in the church parlor with Mr. Whitford presiding. The following members were present: Mr. Seeley, Mrs. Crisp, Dr. Glenn, Mrs. Glenn, Mr. Haywood, Mrs. Gates, Mary Canada, and Ed Coble.

Mr. Whitford read the notes which he had taken at the last meeting.

Mrs. Gates reported that she was working on her files so that they would be ready for use during the summer. Cards were being provided for each prospective member from the nursery school age through the adults. She said that the young people's phase of this campaign was being stressed.

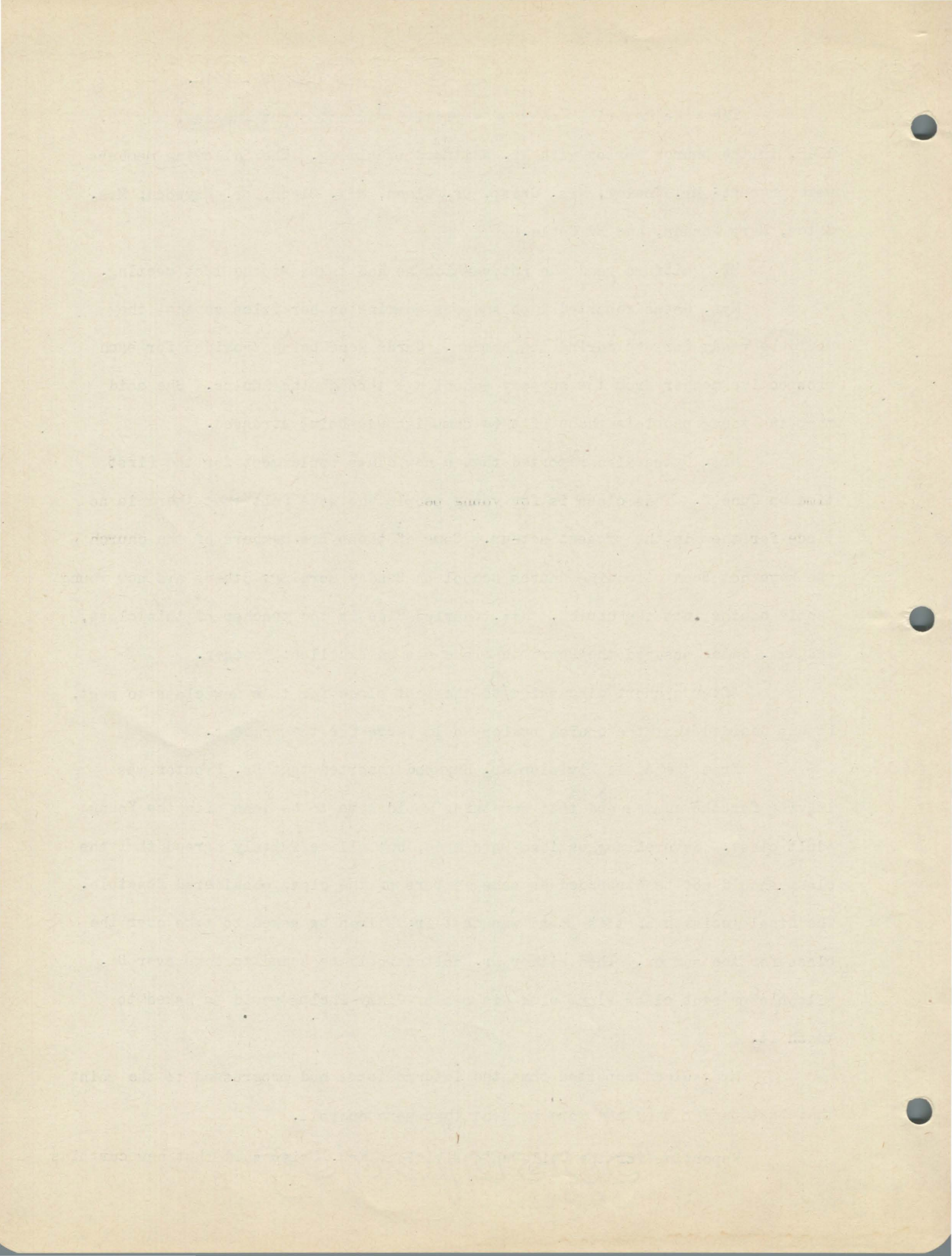
Mrs. Gates also reported that a new class would meet for the first time on June 3. This class is for young people who have felt that there is no place for them in the present set-up. Some of these are members of the church who have not been attending church school on Sunday morning; others are new young people coming into the church. Mrs. Charles Rice is the teacher of this class, and Mrs. Gates assured the Board that she was an excellent teacher.

After a short discussion/^{as}to the best place for this new class to meet, it was decided that the church parlor would serve for the present.

From the Adult Division Mr. Haywood reported that Dr. Proctor was leaving for the summer and that something would have to be done with the Young Adult class. Several suggestions were made, but all definitely agreed that the class should not be disbanded as some members of the class considered feasible. The final decision of this Board was that Dr. Wilson be asked to take over the class for the summer. Then either Dr. Holton would be asked to take over Dr. Wilson's present class along with his own or Jimmy Phelps would be asked to teach it.

Mrs. Glenn reported that the Intermediates had progressed to the point that last Sunday they had more present than were on roll.

Reporting for the Children's Division, Mrs. Crisp said that new curtains



had been put up in Mrs. Wolfe's department. The Vacation Bible School had been completely set up, and she read a list of the teachers and of the books to be studied.

It was moved and voted to authorize the purchase of films to be used by the Vacation Bible School if necessary.

Mr. Whitford stressed the fact that the Board should have the fixed meeting date of the fourth Tuesday night after the fourth Sunday in each month.

Mrs. Gates asked that the Gleaner's Class be allowed to add "Classmates" to their literature.

The meeting was then adjourned.
