As noted above the enrollment of 827 persons compares favorably with the 676 enrolled the same date last year. The attendance average of 433 for this quarter is the best attendance experienced during the corresponding quarter for the past five years. The next best record being 408 for the period of last year.

The Sunday School department is continuing to have its problems caused by lack of teachers and experienced guidance, yet there is more enthusiasm demonstrated by those who are teaching and working in the various departments than I have seen previously. We need the services of a full time leader and organizer to really go places.
