

The monthly meeting of the Board of Christian Education of Duke Memorial Church was held August 25, 1947 in Mrs. Ray Hook's office at 8:00 o'clock with Mr. Whitford presiding.

The committee that was to look into the matter of a social or game room for the church and particularly the young people reported ~~thata~~ ~~they~~ felt that such a project should be put off until a more convenient time, and that the young people were ~~conneled~~ to concentrate on the addition and use of the recreational equipment available. It was suggested that more equipment be bought and that the church should be open to the young people during the week for their use.

Mr. Whitford reported that there would be no church school until school started, and then the question of teachers was discussed. Mr. Whitford said that several were needed and asked that everyone be thinking of possible ones for primary and junior departments. A superintendent for the primary department was reported needed since Mrs. Seeley had resigned.

Mr. Boddie stated that he hoped to give up the intermediate department and also said that he was going to contact Mr. Irving Allen as a possible one to relieve him of his duties.

Dr. Bookhout also suggested that Miss Margaret Umberger take his place as superintendent of the youth division beginning February 1, since his leave of absence from Duke will begin then. He stated that he would resume his superintendency after he returned.

Dr. Bookhout stated that a new religious education director would be needed February 1 and that at the next meeting a committee would be appointed to work with the committee from the stewards on selecting a new director.

There being no further regular business the group was given a copy of the newly suggested educational program for Duke Memorial Church, and asked to study it for discussion at the next meeting.
