I do not feel that it is doing justice to him for me to keep just hanging on indefinitely.

I do know that Mr. Whitford needs assistance right now because plans are under way by some of the departments that could keep one person busy eight hours a day for seven days a week. These are wonderful plans that the departmental superintendents and teachers are working on but they will need assistance. Mr. Whitford cannot keep on doing this work alone.

I wish to thank each member of the Board for his cooperation and I am very grateful for the fellowship I have found among you. You may rest assured that I will always have this work at heart and my best wishes and sincere prayers go out for our Children's Division, Sunday School, and Church.
