

June 3, 1948

The Duke Memorial Board of Christian Education met on June 3 at 8 p.m. in the Church Parlor. The following members were present: Dr. Bookhout, Mrs. Allen, Mrs. Gates, Mrs. Hook, Mrs. Stone, Mr. Cousins, Dr. Seeley, Mrs. Mattox, Mr. Whitford and Mr. Boddie.

The question of a club room for the young people was discussed. The passageway between the Pastor's adde's class and the kitchen was suggested as a possibility. It was agreed that because of lack of space this is about the only room available. Three objections to the room were stated: (1.) it is a passageway (2) the cleaning problem (3) no way to shut it off from being plundered. It was shown that the room could be made attractive with comfortable chairs, paint or wallpaper, and other additions. Mrs. Hook pointed out that the young people need an attractive place now and that this might help to meet the emergency.

It was voted to appoint a committee to work with young people and the church board to draw up specifications for the specified room as a lounge or gathering place for the young people. Dr. Seeley appointed the following committee: Mrs. Hook, Dr. Bookhout, Mr. Boddie. They are to confer also with Mr. Whitford.

Next Wednesday night is to be the first play night for the Intermediates.

Mrs. Hook suggested that a church picnic and religious movie sometimes later in the summer would be a good plan. The Board voted in favor of this.

Mrs. Hook reported that she had spent the \$50 petty cash fund alloted to her, and she was voted another \$50 fund.
