The Board of Christian Education of Duke Memorial Methodist Ehurch met on Wednesday, January 5, 1949 in Mrs. Hook's office with the following members present: Dr. Bookhout, Mrs. Lee, Mr. Boddie, Mrs. Gates, Mr. Manfield, Mr. Helm, Mr. Cousins, Dr. Seeley, Mrs. Stone, Mr. Umberger, Mrs. Hook, Mr. Whitford, and a visitor, Mrs. Cranford.

According to Mrs. Hook, Troy Barrett will be here on February

18, 15, and 16 for the school of youth workers. After some discussion

of whether this course should be accredited or not, the Board voted

that the decision should be left to the people who attend the

meetings.

Mrs. Hook reported the following results of Christmas projects:

Church world service -- 65 pack-a-towel; 38-39 pocketbooks;
plus extras; 9-10 bags of men's suits;
3-4 bags of other clothes; \$13.09
to send money order; \$64 to 6hurch
world service

Home woship services -- many instances of use reported.

Suggested that this be an annual custom.

Mr. Brown reported that Wallace Lee had been sent to the Methodist Orphanage in Raleigh as a part of a Christmas party. After discussion of these and other projects carried out at Christmas, the Board voted that these the bulletin should carry a report on these projects so that the entire church would know what was done.

The Library was discussed and the Board voted to make January 30 bring-a-book Bunday for the whole church.

Margaret Umberger was elected to servée as superimtendent of the Young People's department during the absence of Dr. Bookhout.

Mrs. Hook suggested that it is not too early to be thinking

about a church membership class. A special effort is to be made to get all nonchurch intermediates interested in attending this chass. The Board voted that these sessions should be held for the eight weeks preceding Easter, once a week.

The time for the vacation Bible school was set for one week after the city schools close, and it is to last for two weeks. Miss Johnson, the incoming director of religious education, was elected to be the superintendent of this school.

The choir is again giving trouble by its early Sunday morning practice. Mrs. Hook suggested that the staff come together for regular discussions and understand each other's plans.

Mr. Cousins brought up the question of a unified or coordinate budget for the entire church. He reported that Mr. Angier is now giving the chruch school moneies to Miss Cox to deposit on Monday with the regular offerings. The church school then spends this money plus its alloted \$700 per annum. A lengthy discussion of the general financial policy of the church followed and the Board climaxed its discussion by voting to approve all of the general idea of the unified budget and of the various steps to be taken in that general direction.

Mr. Umberger explained the Young Adult situation to the Board dividing and asked its help in dividing the two classes now combined.

Mr. Umberger, Lester Smith, and Dr. Seeley are to meet and to find the best method of accomplishing this.

Mr. Bishop, secretary of the church school, was affected to membership on the Board, and Mr. Forrester was elected to take the place of Mrs. Allen who has resigned.

Mrs. Gates asked that the members of the Board think about a place for keeping the church archives.
