
Mr. Jones stated that there was presently the sum of \$3,256.67 on deposit at the Wachovia Bank and that month end obligations approximated \$1865.00.


In order to stimulate interest in the Thanksgiving and Christmas offerings, Mr. Dozier suggested that a carefully worded letter be mailed to the membership, or perhaps a Christmas Tree be placed in the lobby of the church suggesting that presents be given in the form of a special contribution. After discussion, Mr. Jones moved that the practice of applying Thanksgiving and Christmas offerings direct to our Orphanage obligations be continued. This motion, duly seconded, was adopted by members present.

The Reverend Mr. Queen stated that he had heard some comment regarding the recent custom of furnishing weekly information in the church bulletin regarding the financial condition of the church. It was the consensus of opinion that the practice is very informative and merits retention with the full endorsement of the Commission.

In concluding the meeting, the Chairman stated Mrs. Kale was in the process of preparing a geographical list of commitment information to be given official board members, and requested that Messrs Jones, White, and Jordan remain to assist her in the work.
