

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE COMMISSION ON FINANCE  
AND STEWARDSHIP EDUCATION

January 22, 1958

A regular meeting of the Commission on Finance and Stewardship Education was held in the Dining Room of the Church at 6:30 P. M. on Wednesday, January 22, 1958. In the absence of Dr. John Glasson, regular Chairman, Marshall Spears presided.

Mrs Kale reported that the Church Treasury was approximately \$4,500.00 behind in payment of Church obligations. According to the bulletin as of Sunday, January 26, 1958, it was stated that \$35,638.00 had been received out of a total annual budget of \$72,058.00, leaving the treasury \$5,942.00 in arrears as of that date.

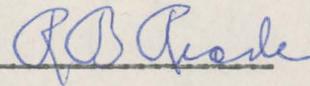
In an attempt to alleviate this situation, Mr. Spears stated that his committee to increase subscriptions had gone over commitment cards and made pencil notations on those members who might increase their donations. Mrs Kale remarked that she too had made notations on some of the stewards lists in an effort have certain members make an increase over and above their original pledge.

Mr. Brooks suggested that in-arrears members be notified more frequently, perhaps on a monthly notice basis, with a printed statement, showing the amount needed to complete their pledge in an orderly manner.

Commenting upon the fact that he, as Chairman of the Methodist Mens Project Committee, had submitted a proposal to purchase a new communion service and table costing approximately \$1600.00, Mr. Dunham requested approval of the Commission, in order that he might continue with the project. Upon motion of Brooks, duly seconded by Perian, the Commission wholeheartedly approved Mr. Dunham's project, with the proviso that the matter be cleared with the official body of stewards meeting at its

next regular session. Mr. Dunham also asked for and was granted permission to go over the church's roster in an attempt to formulate a list of prospective donors.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion, adjourned with the notification that regular Chairman, Dr. John Glasson, would set the date and time of the next meeting in February.
