

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE COMMISSION ON STEWARDSHIP
AND FINANCE

May 27, 1959

A regular meeting of the Commission on Stewardship and Finance was held in the Dining Room of the Church at 6:30 P. M. on Wednesday, May 27, 1959 with Chairman, Dr. John Glasson, presiding.

Reporting on the church treasury, Mr. Jones stated that the sum of \$7,700.93 had been deposited during the month of May and \$2,825.82 was presently the balance in the bank. He further stated that, out of total May collection, he hoped to pay \$3,000 on conference obligations, leaving a similar amount to be paid in June.

With reference to the Every Member Canvass, the Chairman reported that commitment cards received to date totalled \$55,799.55 which is \$6,000.00 more than was pledged altogether last year. In addition, approximately \$8,420.00 was expected from those members who support the church without making a definite commitment. A final report will be made during the June meeting by Mr. Tom White, chairman of the campaign. As commendation for the excellent job done by the young solicitors, Mr. Brooks suggested that a letter of thanks be written to each of them.

Mr. Jones stated that social security covering church employees was now in operation and deductions had been made for the first week. With approval of the Commission, he suggested that the church pay for a full quarter beginning April 1, 1959. He also reported that Mr. Barton had authorized no present change in the maid's weekly salary.

On account of Dr. Jordan's recent illness, the Chairman reported that the music committee had made no final decision on the quior matter and that he was awaiting advisement from Mr. Alley, Chairman of the Committee.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was upon motion, adjourned.
