Reporting on the attempt to raise funds for the purpose of providing furniture for Minister of Education's home, Mr. Jones stated that as of the present date the sum of \$1892.00 had been received, leaving \$608.00 uncollected. He further stated that there remained a balance of \$8300.00 due on the assumed mortgage on his home after applying the \$3,500.00 received from sale of the Kent Street property.

Having been requested to ascertain the cost of providing six tables to be used in providing additional facilities for family night suppers, Mr. Coman stated that they could be purchased at a cost of \$32.47 each. Upon motion of Mr. Dozier, seconded by Mr. Coman, and carried, the commission authorized that the official board be informed of our suggestion that the tables be purchased.

Mr. Coman also informed the Commission that the purchaser of church property on Kent Street had indicated a willingness to install and pay for half the cost of erecting an iron fence on north-south property line of the above mentioned lot. After motion of Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. R. C. White, and carried, the commission again suggested that the official board be requested to authorize the erection of such a fence at an approximate cost of \$86.20 to the church.
