A regular meeting of the Commission on Stewardship and Finance was held in the Dining Room of the Church at 6:00 o'clock P. M. on Wednesday, May 29,1963 with Chairman, Tom White, presiding.

## The Treasurer's report is as follows:

In closing his remarks, the treasurer stated that there remained approximately \$12,000.00 unpaid on pledges that are considered good, and that, in his opinion, sufficient funds would be on hand by the close of the church year to pay all of our obligations by a close margin. In the event that recent invoices mailed to church members did not bring in sufficient funds, however, it would be necessary to make personal calls on those members.

Reporting on present results of the Every Member Canvass, Mr. McLean stated that total pledges on hand amount to \$54,000.00 and that there remained cards outstanding in the approximate sum of \$20,000.00 represented by those who pledged or paid a like amount last year.

Commenting on the diligent devotion that Mr. Jones had displayed in carrying out his duties as treasurer of the church for the past 20 years, Mr. Dozier stated, through motion duly seconded by Mr. Glasson and unanimously approved by the Commission, that a committee be appointed to prepare an appropriate plaque expressing the official board's and the congregation's appreciation.

Briefly reporting on affairs of interest to the church, the pastor stated that the Reverend Mr. Paul Fendt, who, on account of a serious and prolonged illness to himself and other members of his family, was unable to assume a normal pastoral relationship in the conference, Since Mr. Fendt has now become a member of this church, he has expressed a desire to become one of its associate pastors on a non-assignment basis so that he may draw illness compensation from the conference. Upon motion of Mr. Goad, seconded by Mrs Borland and carried, the Commission recommended to the official board that the Reverend Mr. Fendt be appointed as associate pastor of Duke Memorial Churach under the arrangement that he formerly had with Mt. Sylvan Church.

As a final matter of business, the Chairman stated that architect's final plans for the construction of the educational building had been placed in the hands of a selected list of building contractors who had been instructed to present bids to be opened on June 14,1963.

After prayer by Mr. Dozier, the meeting, upon motion was adjourned.
