We are sadly disappointed that the Peru Mission trip has had to be delayed. Five from Duke Memorial were scheduled to join four others from our Annual Conference and travel to Peru October 18 - 28. Early last week, we received a letter by fax from the Bishop of Peru withdrawing our invitation due to "internal problems." We have known for quite some time that the church in Peru has been struggling over internal leadership issues which are much too complicated to explain in this brief column. At this point, however, things have gone from bad to worse.

There are those within the Peru church who were very saddened by their bishop's withdrawal of our invitation. Part of our covenant relationship is our desire to accompany one another even in our darkest moments. But Bishop Mamani is insisting that there are some internal things which need to be resolved before they are able to receive us. Our North Carolina bishop, C.P. Minnick, agrees that we should honor the Peru bishop's request. One needs to understand that Peru has gone through 12 years of tremendous unrest due to the terrorist activity of the Shining Path. This unrest has left nothing untouched, including the religious life of the people of Peru. In many ways our Methodist Church of Peru has also fallen victim and this is one reason why our covenant relationship with them has been so important over the past four years.

I would ask that you keep the Methodist Church of Peru in your prayers. It is my hope that Para Drake, Kevin Baker, Donna Elium, Courtney Smith and I will be able to reschedule this trip for early next year. The General Assembly of the Peru Church meets in late November and we pray that further reconciliation will take place at that time. Meanwhile, all monies received in support of the Peru Mission will be held in a separate account for that purpose. We are grateful for your continued support and prayers.



Our part-time custodian has been invited to join the Substance Abuse Task Force by the County of Durham's Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services. The area board and management team of the Mental Health Center have strongly committed to develop a long range planning process that includes representation from those individuals in the community that are closely involved or impacted by the abuse of alcohol and other drugs.

Almost two years ago, our Staff-Parish Relations Committee took a chance on a woman who had just begun a recovery program from drug addition. Our church gave this woman, Linda Evans, a part-time job when others were afraid that she might relapse and steal from them to support her addiction. We gave her an opportunity.

The Good News which we shared with Linda Evans through a job and a supportive community of staff and church members, has truly produced fruit. Her recovery has been remarkable enough to get her interviewed last year on a WUNC-TV program about alternative sentencing in our prison system, and now she has been selected to serve on an important task force!
