## "I'll Quit Tomorrow"

Members of the Duke Memorial congregation are invited to a showing of the film, "I'll Quit Tomorrow" at Trinity United Methodist Church, October 18, at 7:30 p.m.

The film deals with Alcoholism, what it is, how it manifests itself; and teaches us how to be effectively involved in the dynamics of treatment and recovery.

The storyline of the film tells of what happened to Steve Miller and his family as he develops the illness of alcoholism, describing how it progressed in his family and work life. It also describes the behavior of the significant persons around Steve and gives help in effective intervention by family and employers.
