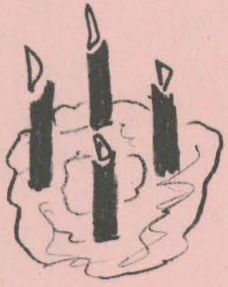


ADVENT WORKSHOP

A. You may choose among these three activities: (for everyone)

1. MAKE AN ADVENT WREATH - To be taken home for worship on the Sundays during Advent. Advent Worship Suggestions will also be provided. Supplies (wreath forms, greenery, and candles) will be available to make about 25 wreaths. A 75¢ contribution is asked to help cover the cost of materials for the wreath. Candles will be available for an additional 75¢. Caroline Sasser will be there to show you how!
2. MAKE GIFTS FOR SHUT-INS - Materials and instructions will be given for making several items that will then be taken to our shut-in members as a remembrance from our church family during the Christmas season. Your instructor in this center will be Mary Ann Mabry.
3. MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS CARDS - Share an original touch that is your own special Christmas greeting. Polly Mixon will have ideas and will help you implement your own.

B. MAKE STONE SOUP (This is a special activity for men *under the direction of Monika Bollinger*)

What's Stone Soup, you say? Well, you'll just have to come and find out! But you'll have to do more than just come - you'll have to bring something to put in the soup pot. It may be a can of tomatoes, or a package of frozen corn, or a soup bone - whatever you think tastes good in soup - bring it! Immediately upon arrival at the church, take your item to the kitchen so it can be added to the pot. (Please make sure that whatever you bring will be ready to serve after being cooked for about 45 minutes. You may want to cook meat ahead at home.)
