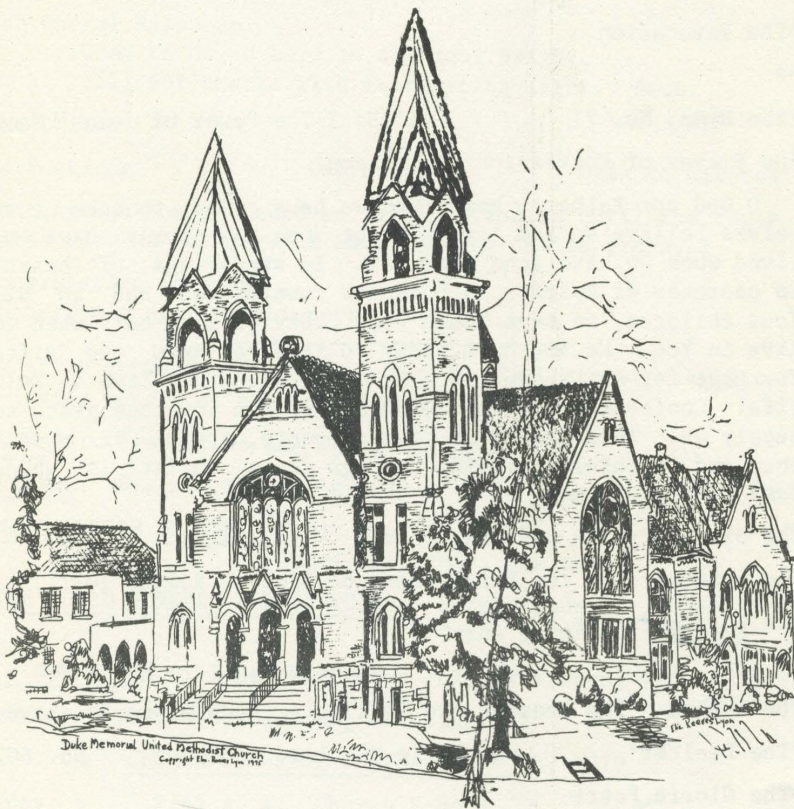


Duke Memorial United Methodist Church
