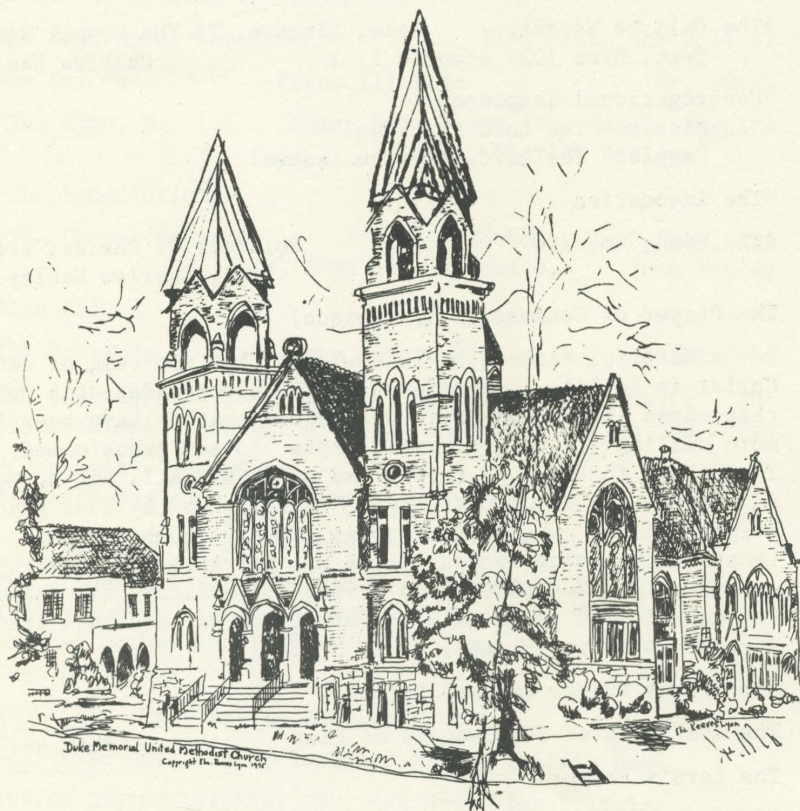


# Duke Memorial United Methodist Church
