THE SPEAKER

Well-known as a speaker and leader at youth gatherings, The Reverend Robert W Bradshaw comes to us as the host pastor, having been appointed here last June. The father of three young men, one of whom is Francis C., President of the North Carolina Conference Methodist Youth Fellowship, Mr. Bradshaw has contributed to the summer assembly and camp program almost continuously since he began an eight year tenure as Conference Director of Youth Work in 1935. A graduate of Trinity College (now Duke University) and the Duke Divinity School, our speaker has served 27 years in the ministry, following eleven years as a teacher and principal. Churches served by Mr. Bradshaw are as follows: Jenkins Memorial, (Raleigh); St. James, (Tarboro); Jarvis Memorial, (Greenville); and First Methodist, (Wilson).

THE WORDS OF THE ANTHEMS
