



Music education curriculum is utilized through special activities, games and movement. The Carol Choir sings in worship 3 to 4 times yearly and participates in the "White Christmas" program. Choir registration and rehearsals begin Wednesday, September 16. This choir fully implements fundamentals learned in Carol Choir. Wesley Singers prepare anthems for worship each month and learn great hymns of the church through the "Hymn of the Month" hymn memorization program. 


This intergenerational group specializes in many styles of contemporary Christian music including folk, gospel and rock. Celebration Singers rehearse the second Monday of each month and meet at 9:30 a.m. the following Sunday to sing in worship. Musical expertise is not expected, only the desire to praise God through song! **SANCTUARY CHOIR** is the primary adult singing ensemble in the church. The Sanctuary Choir leads in worship each week. The choir presents several major musical services throughout the year. This year we will present an Advent/ Christmas Festival of Lessons and Carols with Brass and Percussion, a February Dinner and Broadway Musical Revue, and a Lenten Cantata within the Good Friday Service of Darkness. There will also be special choral and instrumental music for High Holy Day services throughout the year.

Next summer (June 28, 1993 - July 10), members of the Sanctuary Choir and Epworth Choir will form the North Carolina Wesley Festival Choir for a concert tour of churches in Bavaria, Austria and Switzerland.

While we always strive for choral excellence, the Sanctuary Choir welcomes new members at any time.

**BETHANY BELLS** is an adult handbell choir which leads in worship every 4 to 6 weeks and participates in several area handbell festivals.



#### OTHER WAYS TO SERVE

**ATTEND WORSHIP!** Worship provides the greatest opportunity for ministry through music. In addition to the inspiring music provided by our many choirs, members of the congregation are encouraged to embrace hymn-singing as an active exercise in worship.
