The Duke Memorial Methodist Church Nursery School is making plans for the 1957-58 session. As a part of your church's program, you as a member or you whose child attends church school here, are given the opportunity to enroll your child in the school before applications are considered from other persons. In order to make available the necessary time for making fall plans, we are requesting that you send in your enrollment application before June 1 of this year.

The school which is for three and four year old boys and girls operates in two sessions. One group meets on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays from 9:00 a. m. until 12:00 noon. The tuition for this group is eight dollars and fifty cents (\$8.50) per month. Another group meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the same hours, the tuition for this group is six dollars (\$6.00) per month. A child cannot be entered until he has reached his third birthday.

This non-profit school is cooperative in that each child's mother helps in the teaching program at the church approximately once every month. Attendance at a monthly business or educational meeting is also a part of the cooperative philosophy of the school.

The nursery day school is an outstanding opportunity for your child to have the experience of learning to share and play with children his or her own age, of having contact and developing security outside the home, and of having a happy relationship with the church. The school is also a valuable opportunity for you to learn much about the childhood education.


