DUKE MEMORIAL NURSERY SCHOOL MINUTES (1950-51)

The fifth meeting of the Duke Memorial Nursery School was brought to order by the chairman, Mrs. Pyne, on January 11, 1951. Mrs. Irwin introduced the speaker, Mrs. Marianna Howard, who gave an interesting talk on what children like to hear and listed books as examples.

The minutes were read and accepted. The treasurers report showed a balance of \$181.95. The membership chairman reported 24 enrolled and asked if anyone knew of other mothers who might like to enroll their children. The Mother Assistant and Transportation Chairman reported that it will be necessary for all mothers to assist 6 times from January to the end of the school year.

A letter of thanks from Wrights Refuge was read.

A motion to donate \$100.00 for the purpose of fencing in a different play area was made and passed. Another motion was passed to allow but 2 absences from the evening monthly meetings with additional absences to be voted on by the group. A request was made that all anticipated absences from the evening meetings be reported to the Secretary in advance.
