

Commission on Education

February 27, 1962

The Commission on Education met on February 27, 1962, at 7:45 in the home of the Warren Bishops, with Mrs. Dozier presiding. Thirteen members were present.

After a prayer by Warren Bishop the chairman called for reports. Mr. Whitford said that orders for literature from the Sunday School were not coming in on time from some classes; attendance is good. Tom Coble reported good results from the combined meeting of adult classes. Mrs. Brinkley's report gave the need for a temporary replacement for Mr. A. B. Windham as secretary of the Intermediate Department.

Mrs. Ferguson stated that two students in Religious Education at Duke are observing and helping in the Children's Division.

Tom McCauley reported that an evening group, college age and slightly older, is meeting at the church on the 1st and 3rd Sundays. The group is a combination of young people from Trinity, St. Paul and Duke Memorial.

Jack Cliff reported that attendance is good.

Vacation Bible School was discussed. 1. A motion was made by Jack Cliff, seconded by Tom Coble, that Vacation Church School be held for a period of five days, Monday through Friday. Passed. 2. Tom Langford moved, Mr. Whitford seconded the motion, that the Vacation Church School start July 16 and end the 20th, with a Family night to be held on July 20. Passed. 3. Tom Langford made the motion that the chairman, in consultation with Mrs. Ferguson, appoint a committee to recruit personnel for the Vacation Bible School.

Day Camp was discussed. Juniors are eligible to attend.

The budget will be studied at the March meeting.

Day School for the next year was discussed. At present 9 are enrolled for the 5 year group from Duke Memorial, 4 others are interested; 8 are enrolled in the 4 year group; none so far are enrolled in the 3 year group.

Warren Bishop made several announcements. On Friday, March 9, Duke Memorial will be host to the Commission on Church Vocations. Groups attending will include Junior and Senior High students from the Burlington, Raleigh and Durham Districts. Sunday, March 18, will be the observance of Girl Scout Sunday.
