

Report to Administrative Board
August 1, 1989

Due to the Capital Campaign meetings and my vacation in June, it has been some time since I have made a report to the Board. Below are some highlights of the activities in which I've been involved:

The Council on Ministries spent a day at Avila in early April. The focus of the retreat was on spiritual enrichment and personal ministry.

Also in April, the Celebration Singers got off the ground. The group, which now numbers 12, shared in worship for the first time on July 16.

Another group which met in April was the Pre-School/Nursery Task Force. The task force was composed of parents who have children in our church nurseries. They made recommendations to the Work Area on Education regarding ways to upgrade our program and facilities for our expanding numbers of pre-school children.

Because we did not have major programs going on during the Capital Campaign, I took some time to do three workshops for continuing education credit. The Annual Conference requires 40 hours of continuing education per year to keep my certification current.

The second half of May was a joyous and busy time. We observed Teacher Appreciation Day on May 21 and presented 35 hand-painted cups filled with notes of appreciation to our Sunday School teachers and leaders.

The J.O.Y. Class presented the musical LIGHTSHINE! to an audience of 150 people on May 21. The youth had been preparing that program since January.

The staff also served a luncheon on May 25, for the 30 persons who assist as office volunteers.

S.A.M. (Single Adult Ministry) held an organizational dinner on July 23. Donna Elium gave leadership as the group discussed possible future plans. The next meeting will be August 27.

MUSIC AND DRAMA CAMP has just finished under the leadership of Ann Stallings and Ruth Phelps. In addition, Para Drake helped organize VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL for younger children which took place during the same hours as the Camp. During the week, we had 120 children and 25 adults participating in the two programs.

Coming events in the next weeks are: Day Camp, COM budget planning for 1990, Christian Education/Promotion Sunday, and the Program Fair.
