#### IV. WORK AND PROGRAM OF THE LOCAL CHURCH

The new Conference year has begun in a satisfactory manner at Duke Memorial Church and we look forward to a good year in every phase of our church's program. The Every Member Canvass was held in May and the largest pledge was made to the church budget that has been made in a number of years. The Budget was increased to \$80,000, but we believe the loyal support of our members will make it possible to meet the Budget in full by the end of the Conference year.

In the month of August, by action of a Special Session of the Quarterly Conference and of a Church Conference called for that purpose, a new parsonage was bought for the Minister of Education at a cost of \$24,000. One half the purchase price was paid at the time of purchase, added payment will be made when the sale of a lot on Kent Street, a sale authorized by the Quarterly Conference and Church Conference, is made, and the balance will be taken care of by the amount set up in the budget for rent.

All organizations in the church are functioning in a satisfactory manner. Rally Day and Promotion day were observed on September 27, with the largest Sunday School attendance for the year. A Dedication Service was held at the morning worship hour for all workers in the Church School and for the Official Board.

A group is meeting monthly under the Commission on Membership and Evangelism to plan and make visits in the name of the church to prospective members, newcomers in the community, and others who we consider on our "responsibility" list.

Attendance upon all services has been satisfactory. 105 tickets were sold for the Evangelistic Rally in Raleigh. Our first Sunday night service was held this past Sunday with over 100 in attendance. Tomorrow night we will have our first Prayer Meeting service. The Sunday night and Wednesday night services now become a regular part of our program.

We are grateful to God for the leading of His Spirit and for the blessing of His Power in all that we undertake to do for Him.
