Pastor's Report to First Quarterly Conference

December 6, 1960

We have had a very satisfactory year thus far in the life of Duke Memorial Church. Every organization in the church is doing its job well, attendance in all phases of the church's worship and service has been good, and the spirit of the leaders and of the people has been most encouraging. We feel that we are ready for greater things ahead.

The Commissions of the church are functioning well. The Commission on Stewardship and Finance meets regularly and leads the congregation to an increasing awareness of its responsibility and its opportunity. Plans are already under way to carry on the Every Member Canvass in the spring. The chairman has been selected, and the careful preparation of a church budget will be begun early in the new calendar year.

The Commission on Education has its regular monthly meetings and gives careful consideration to every detail of its program. Teachers and officers have been elected and installed, a leadership training program is under way, the Sunday School is well-staffed, and the MYF groups are doing a good job.

The Chairman of the Commission on Missions brings regularly to the Board bits of information and inspiration to keep the Board mindful of its opportunity in this field of service.

The Commission on Membership and Evangelism has a Visitation group that meets every month, keeps in touch with all prospects for church membership, works to enlist new members and then helps to assimilate these new members into our church life. Through the efforts of this group 52 new members have been added to the church family this year.

There is a growing sense of need on the part of many ileaders and other members for added facilities to take care of the expanded program that is becoming a part of the life of our church. This has resulted in the appointing of a Survey Committee to make a thorough study of our physical needs and to report to the board and the congregation how their needs can be met through new facilities and the better utilization of our present facilities. We expect this Committee to make its study and report its findings as soon as possible. Then the Board and congregation will develop plans for carrying out the recommendations of this Committee.

We feel the future is bright for our church, and we hope to feel and to follow the leading of God's Spirit in fulfilling our responsibility for this future.
