Pastor's Report
Fourth Quarterly Conference
April 9, 1963

The work of Duke Memorial Church has moved forward in a satisfactory manner since our last Quarterly Conference. All phases of the church's program have been carried on well by those charged with their responsibilities, and the response of the congregation to the leadership in the different parts of the program has been good.

Preliminary plans for the new building and the renovation of other facilities were presented to the congregation and approved at a Church Conference called for that purpose. Detailed plans and specifications are in process of being prepared and the architects have said they will be ready very shortly. We trust it will not be long before we can break ground for the new building. Payments on Building Fund pledges are being paid each Sunday and something over one hundred thousand dollars is in the Building Fund, not counting money available for the Building from the Memorial Fund.

The ministers have conducted a church membership class this spring and 17 boys and girls will be received into the church on Thursday evening, April 11. This will give us a total of 64 new members received during the year thus far and we expect to have other new members before the close of the Conference year.

There are many ways in which the leaders and members of the church have shown their loyalty and devotion to God and to His church during this year. For this the pastor is deeply grateful. It is his hope and prayer that there will be continued spiritual growth in the lives of all of us during the remainder of the year.


We are constantly praying for the leading of God's spirit in all that we do and we are grateful to Him for that Spirit that draws us close to Him and closer to one another.
