Again the time for reflection upon a past years work causes me to give hearty thanks to God for his blessing upon my life, and giving me the strength to go forward to his work. It is a year of accomplishments, and it is felt that in general the work that I have had responsibility for, has progressed very satisfactorily. Among the activities of this office have been the directing of the program of Christian Education, and assisting the pastor in the general duties of the Church.

Specifically, the following things have been carried out with the loyal and devoted help of many fine lay people in Duke Memorial Church.

Vacation Church School: 137 pupils, 40 teachers,
Average Attendance 137, perfect attendance 108.

Junior Day Camp: 19 pupils, 4 staff, average attend-
ance, 18, perfect attendance, 16.

Participation in Planning and Administration of the
next Christian Worker's School.

Vacation Church School Institute held in our Church,
March 4, in which I taught one course.

Participation in the general administrative duties of
the Church, commissions, committees.

Preaching, and participation in the worship services
of the Church, both on Sunday and Wednesday
evenings.

Youth Counselor for Senior High MYF.

Participation in Choir work in Church.

Taught in two Christian Worker's Schools, Roanoke
Rapids, and Snow Hill, also in the Vacation
Church School Institutes for one week.

Participation in the Building Program of the Church.


