> Pastor's Report to Fourth Quarterly Conference March 3, 1964

This report covers the period of four months from November 5, 1963 to March 3, 1964. During this time much of our work has centered about our building program. Renovation has been going on in our present educational building and within a short while this building will be ready for use. This will give us new church offices for all staff members and newly-decorated rooms for our Junior High and Senior High Departments when the new building is ready for use. Work on the new building is progressing in a satisfactory manner and the contractor still expects to have the building ready by the target date of July 1. 1964.

Committees are at work planning the arrangements for use of space in all buildings when we move into the new building and for the furnishings and equipment for the buildings. Many persons are giving of much time that the best preparation possible can be made for the use of our new facilities.

The regular work of the church has gone forward in a satisfactory way. Meaningful experiences were enjoyed during the Christmas season, and leaders in every phase of our church life have carried on their work in an effective manner. The pastor is teaching the mission study book, "Our Mission Today," at the mid-week prayer service.

Plans are now under way for church membership classes for our boys and girls and we look forward to the rich experience of leading young people into their personal church relationship. Special programs will be held during the Easter season.

VI. CONNECTIONAL PROGRAMS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. District Programs—participation in district rallies, subdistrict meetings, summer camps and institutes, financial requests.
2. Annual Conference Programs—participation in Annual Conference rallies, financial apportionments, support of colleges and Wesley Foundations, programs of evangelism, Annual Conference Specials, and development programs.
3. Area, Jurisdictional, and General Conference Programs and Financial Requests—apportionments and participation.

Payments to the church budget have been fairly satisfactory, in the light of the large contributions to the building fund. A special effort will be made during the balance of the Conference year to fulfill all our financial obligations.

We acknowledge the leading of God's spirit in that which we undertake to do for Him.
