The teaching ministry is being strengthened and our church school attendance is showing consistent growth. Church School Rally Day has been observed. The youth program is being strengthened.

Attendance is good at our services of worship. Holy Communion is administered once a month.

Approximately 40 new members have been received since July 1.

The pastor is impressed with the number of laymen assuming places of leadership. The Official Board and Commissions are duly organized and functioning.

Certain administrative changes will enhance our financial position. Our offerings will enable us to meet our obligations for the next year.

The trustees and Building Committee are projecting plans for the renovation of the Sanctuary Building and it is our thought to dedicate the new Educational Building in the spring.

The pastor is grateful for a loyal and cooperative staff.

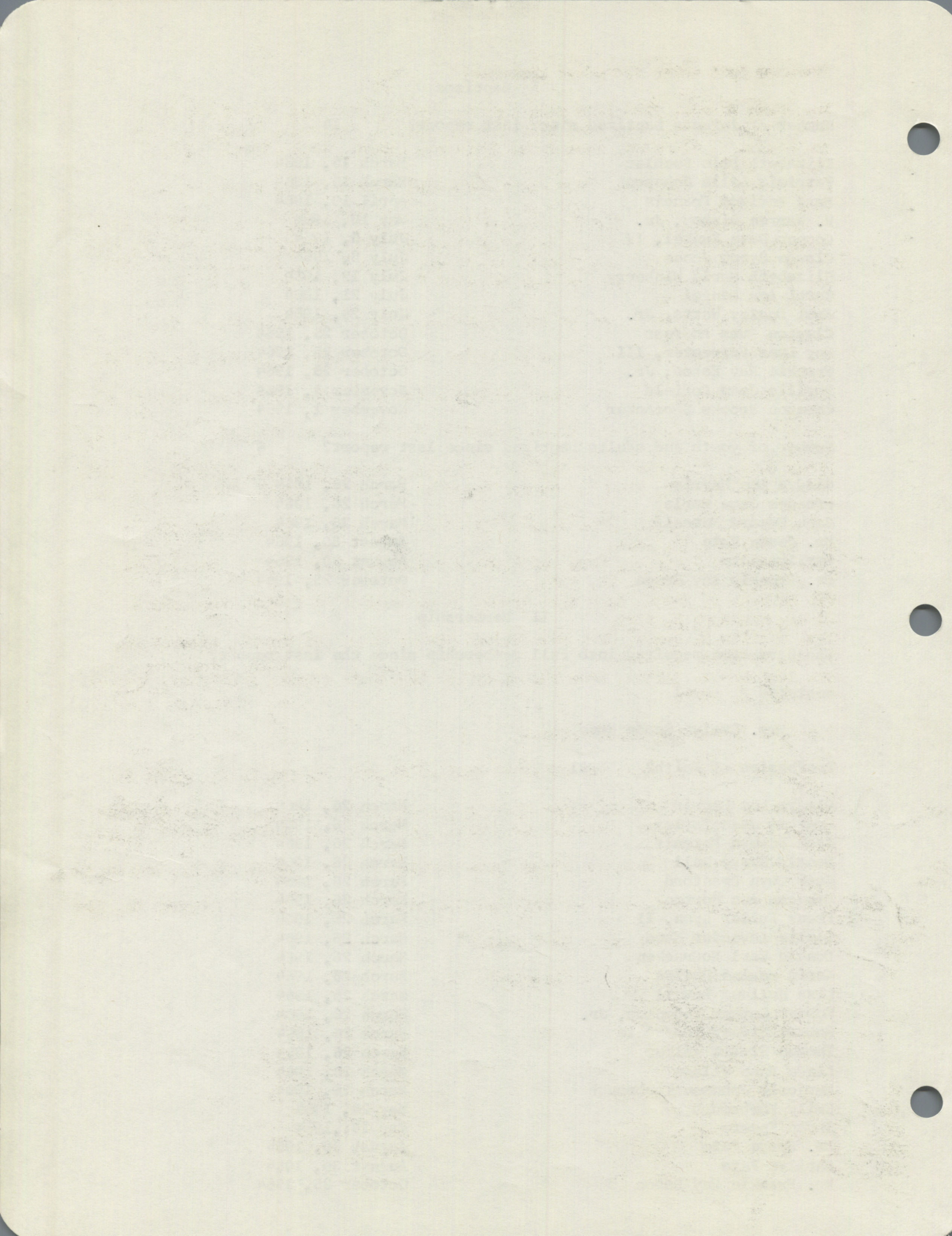

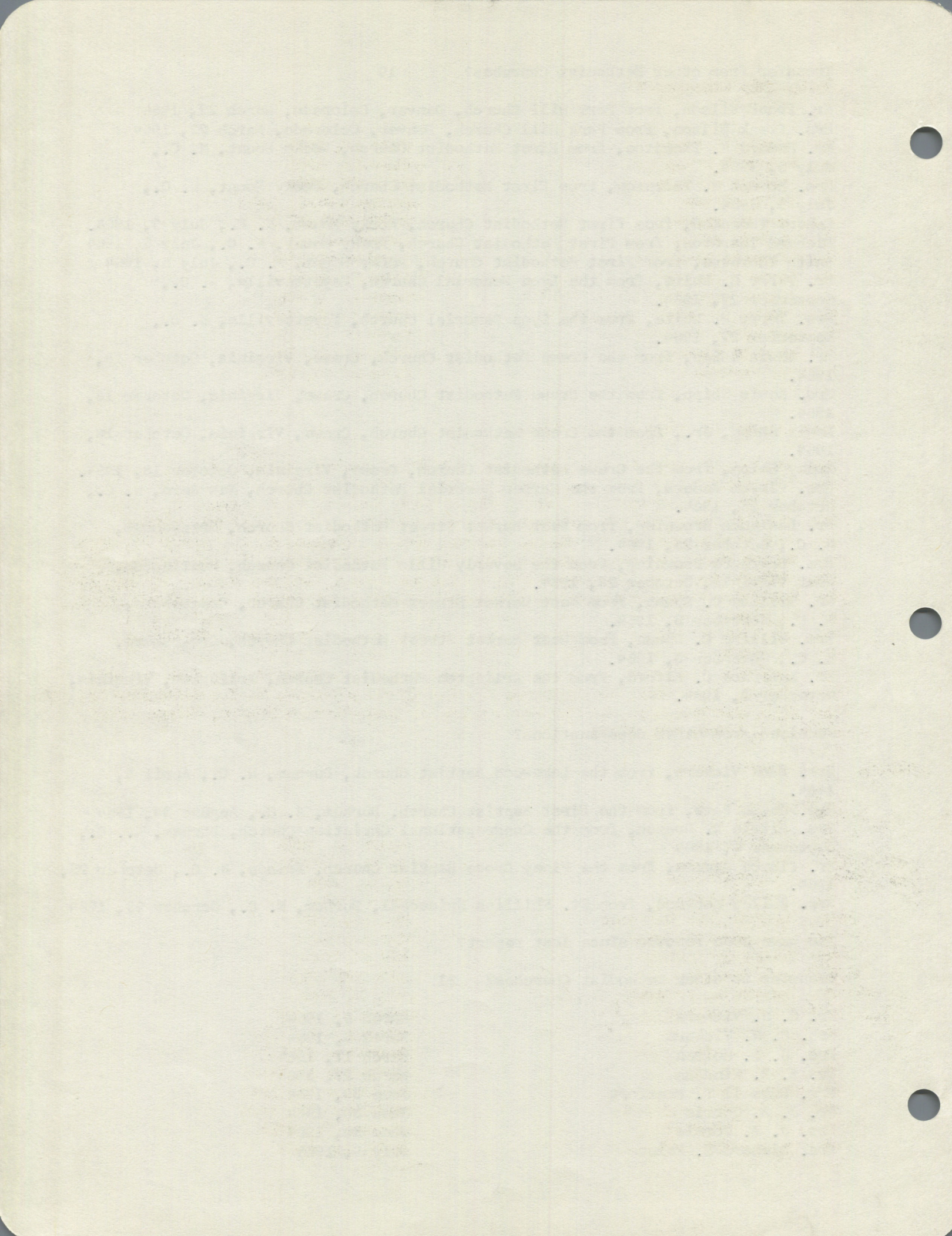

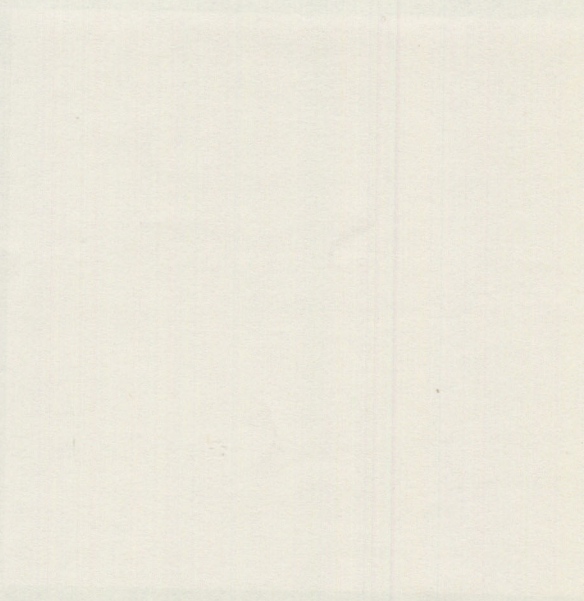
