A Brief Explanation of Suggested Advance Specials

A. World Division:

1. Missionary Salary Support - This is the highest priority among Advance Specials, since missionaries receive the major part of their support through the Advance program. Information on missionaries will be provided upon request.
2. African Church Growth & Development Program - General Code No. 008233-0-H-T; Liberia (Church Growth and Development - \$10,000, Code No. 005712-0-R-A); Mozambique (Evangelism, Literacy, Agricultural Program - Code No. 005752-8-R-A) \$10,000; Nigeria - (Women's Leadership Training - Code No. 007893-1-RA) \$10,300; Zaire (Central Conference: River Boat - Code No. 008092-3H-0; Southern Conference - Kimbulu - Kayeka Theological Seminary Scholarships - Code No. 005773-4-RA, \$30,000; Zimbabwe - Post-war Emergency Aid for Pastors - Code No. 007949-1-RA) \$39,000.
3. Bolivia-Student Loan - For scholarship fund.
4. Brazil-Rio de Janeiro - One of the seven church extension projects located in the Third Region.
5. Supplementary Support, Pastors' Salaries, East Germany - Salaries are very low. This would greatly strengthen the life of the church.
6. The International Nursing Service - An intensive specialized program of academic study and clinical experiences at Emory University for qualified leadership nurses from developing countries of any religion or race. Once trained, nurses will return to their countries to respond to the complete range of human illness and injury to a large percentage of their population.
7. United Methodist Volunteers in Mission to support the Volunteer Program.

B. National Division:

1. Hinton Rural Life Center, Hayesville, NC - This is a leadership training center used by United Methodists from all of the Southeast. Many of our North Carolina pastors and laypersons have benefitted by training here, and will continue to do so.
2. Hinton Rural Life Center, Hayesville, NC - Renovation - construct meeting units for small groups - to repair existing buildings.
3. Robeson County Church and Community Center, Lumberton, NC - This is a unique ministry of the whole Gospel to the whole person in the total community, involving a tri-racial population of 91,000 in the County of Robeson. This Center also influences the surrounding counties.
4. Red Bird Mission, Kentucky - Hunger related project. A comprehensive mission program in the rural mountain area of Southeast Kentucky to help alleviate poverty.
5. United Methodist Volunteers in Mission - to support the Volunteer Program
6. Cherokee United Methodist Church, Cherokee, NC - This congregation is 90% Cherokee and 10% Black and White. The church has an active outreach ministry to the community.

3. United Methodist Camps - Churches can and are encouraged to make special gifts to the camping program as a Conference Advance Special.
4. District Mission Societies - This project is operated by the District - check with the pastor or District Superintendent.
5. District Christmas Offering - This project is supervised by the District Superintendent.
6. Wesley Foundations - To assist United Methodist Ministry at these institutions of higher education.
7. Ethnic Minority Projects
 - a) Black Churches
 - (1) Walnut Terrace Child Development Center
 - (2) St. Peter - Parsonage - Rockingham District. Funds will be provided to assist the congregation.
 - (3) Granville-Vance Charge - Parsonage - Durham District. Funds will assist two small rural congregations in making payments on the indebtedness incurred in building a new parsonage.
 - (4) Mt. Olive Church - Purchasing lot and building - Rockingham District. Church has purchased an old laundry building next to the church building to be converted into classroom space and fellowship hall.
 - (5) Galilee Church - Additional Church School Classrooms - Rockingham District. Classrooms are needed to accommodate the increasing church school attendance.

B. Native American Churches & Projects:

1. Philadelphus Church Development Program - Rockingham District. The congregation has relocated in a thickly settled community and needs assistance to pay for a new building and leadership development.
2. Cooperative Rural Parish and Church and Community Worker - Rockingham District. The parish will strengthen small churches in Christian witness in music, leadership development, senior citizens, youth programs, evangelism, and a community ministry.
3. Fayetteville District Native American Ministries - Fayetteville District. Programs will focus on providing pastoral leadership, outreach programs, and to establish a new congregation.
4. Ashpole Church - Rockingham District. The congregation is heavily in debt in liquidating mortgage on the present building.

C. Tri-Racial Projects:

1. Lighthouse United Methodist Church - Tri-racial congregation organized September, 1979. Has 10 acres of land on which to build a church. Needs to increase building fund.
