During the past year, Duke Memorial has been fortunate in being financially secure even while making payments on a neww sound system and the renovation of its towers. More importantly, there seems to have been a shift in the mood and Spirit of the congregation of Duke Memorial. The church has adjusted to its new staff and is moving with excitement as more people are becoming involved in the administrative and program committees of the church. The people have expressed their confidence in their staff as they have used their natural friendly and caring gifts to greet each other and the visitors at the worship services and Terrific Tuesdays. It is this moving of the Spirit that has created our membership gain this past year, and I feel sure that this trend will continue as long as the Spirit continues to move in the congregation.

I have been pleased that I have been able to participate in a wide range of pastoral duties as Associate Minister of Duke Memorial. I have been involved in the planning and the leadership of the worship services throughout the year. I have preached at about ten of these worship services. In addition I have helped lead the quarterly Lord's Supper celebrations at the 11:00 service and the

monthly celebrations in the Bradshaw Room.

Because much of my work focuses on the visitation of the shutin members of our church I have both assisted and led several funeral services for members who have died and counseled those experiencing the grief of these deaths. I have performed three marriages during the year after pre-marital counseling, and I have performed one baptism.

As I said, much of my work involves visiting shut-in members and I have been enriched by the sharing that has occurred during these visits. I have also assisted in the hospital visitation of members and I have made several visits beyond these two categories. I have been visiting prospective members as needed and when possible

I have done these visits with Oliver Upchurch.

I have had the fortune of being quite involved in the educational business of the church. I have taught many of the classes during the year and helped with the Christian Fellowship Class extensively and helped the Bethany class as it has organized. During the Spring months I led the Confirmation class and took them on the Confirmation Retreat run by the District COM.

Administratively, I have had responsibility for the work area on Family Ministries and have been involved with the Administrative

board and the Council on Ministries.

The year has been very rewarding for me, and I hope the future continues in kind.




