1990

- Nov. 10 - Square Dance. Special children's activities.
- Dec. 9 - White Christmas Program. Children's musical drama.
Children gave 84 gifts to underprivileged children.
- Dec. 5 and 12 - Dinner; programs for children and adults.
- Dec. 19 - Christmas caroling and fruit basket delivery to shut-ins.

1991

- January - organized 4 mornings of cleaning classrooms, painting chairs, etc. Got new carpet for 2 rooms.
- March 16 - Survival Skills for Healthy Families - seminar for adults.
All-day activities for their 30 children.
- March 19 - May 14 - Organized Confirmation Classes for 11 youth.
Met once a week. Had field trips to Jewish Synagogue, Catholic church, a lock-in, and hot dog party our house.
- March 24 - Easter Egg Hunt for children.
- March 31 - Children decorated cross in sanctuary with flowers - Easter.
- April 6-7 - Attended Conference Lab School in Goldsboro, N.C., with 2 other children's teachers.
- April 27 - Children's Worship Service - Blessing of the Bears.
Confirmation Class participated, children's choirs.
- Month of May - 4 tennis clinics set up for children.
- May 26 - Teacher Appreciation Day
- June 2 - Church-wide picnic. Pony rides, relays, fishing for children.
- June 7 - Dinner and inspirational program by Ray Warren on starting a Middle School UMYF. Led other meetings about youth.
- June 18 - Day of Discovery for Preschool Children - park and McDonald's.
- June 27 - Day of Discovery for Elementary Children - field trip to Museum of History, Museum of Natural Science, Pullen Park picnic.
- July 8 - 12 - Vacation Bible School - 97 children, 12 full-time teachers, 40 others helping. 6 week Bible Study for teachers preceding VBS.
- July 22-July 26 - Day Camp - Elementary age. 41 children, 15 of them underprivileged. Held at Camp Chestnut Ridge using their staff, 3 adults from our church, 3 youth.
- August 12-16 - Music and Drama Camp - Music Director organized and staffed. I was a group leader all week.
- August - Recruited new Sunday School teachers and helpers.
Arranged for 2 new classrooms and set up new supply closet.
- August 25 - Promotion Sunday - gave Bibles to 3rd graders, promoted children, honored retiring teachers, introduced new teachers.
- August - Organized fall Parents' Morning Out.
- September - taught Junior Church 3 times and recruited others.
- October 18 - Parents' Night Out program on play and laughter.
- October 23 - Attended Serendipity Workshop in Raleigh, N.C.
- October 27 - "Holy" Ween. Hotdog supper, 10 booths for children like "Go Fishing." 180 people.

Ongoing Programs I supervise - Sunday School- Nursery, classes for 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's, First grade, Second grade, 3rd and 4th grade, and 5th grade, Junior Church, Parents' Morning Out 2 mornings a week, all babysitting - \$6,000 budget 1991.

Shut-In Visitation - Thursday morning set aside for visiting.
Sometimes take others and eat lunch afterwards.
Re-organized shut-in list.
Recruiting and nurturing Visitation Team members.
