
It has been a real pleasure for me to be available as a substitute teacher for the Lillie Duke, the M.P.Gates and the Spence-Kale Sunday School classes throughout the year.

Another type of Ministry that I've enjoyed is that of Chairing the Committe on Senior Travelers for Duke Memorial, Epworth and Trinity local churches. We plan and carry out 3 long trips each year and have experimented just last month with a one day trip. We hope to have more short trips in the future.

Working as a Volunteer at the Duke Medical Center Cancer Center has given me the opportunity to reach out a hand of love and concern to many of the hundreds who come to Duke Hospital. So far we have raised \$10,200,000.00 toward a \$60,000,000.00 endowment for the University. There are now 302 students enrolled in 4 faculities and using 7 dormitories. They received over 3000 applications for the 302 places. So, we have our work cut out for us.
