The year 2006 has been filled with interesting days for ministry at the Divinity School Library, Duke Memorial UMC, and beyond. I continue to believe that God has called me into ministry, and to value the conference's appointment to my work as Director of the Divinity School Library.

I preached once (at a Divinity School worship service), had no baptisms or weddings, and served the sacrament of Holy Communion three times. I taught Sunday school classes three times.

My work in the library has been exciting and intense. I have been fully involved in the faculty of the school as well as in professional meetings of librarians locally and nationally. I continue to chair the Endowment Fund Committee for the American Theological Library Association, a very rewarding job indeed. At Duke, I have participated in four librarian search committees, chairing one.

My involvement in Duke Memorial has increased. With this year, I complete my service on the Staff-Parish Relations Committee. I continue to coordinate the Interfaith Hospitality Network ministries (five weeks in 2006), to sing in the adult choir, and to participate actively in the life of the congregation.

My continuing education in the past year has been varied. I participated in the American Theological Library Association conference in Chicago, and attended several lectures and events in the university, including several events related to the use of technology in teaching.
