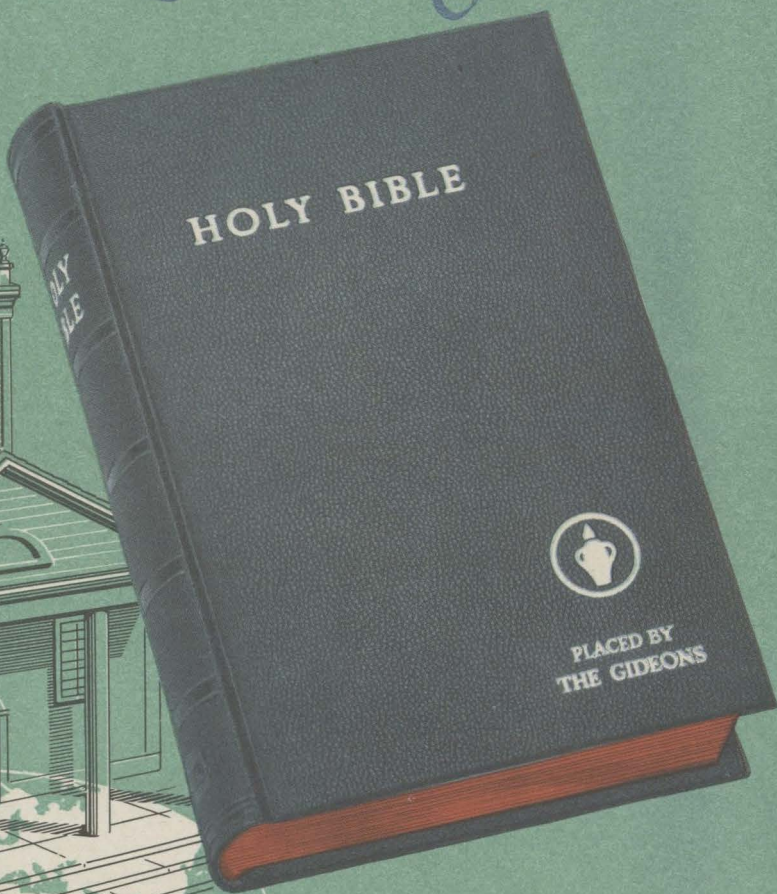
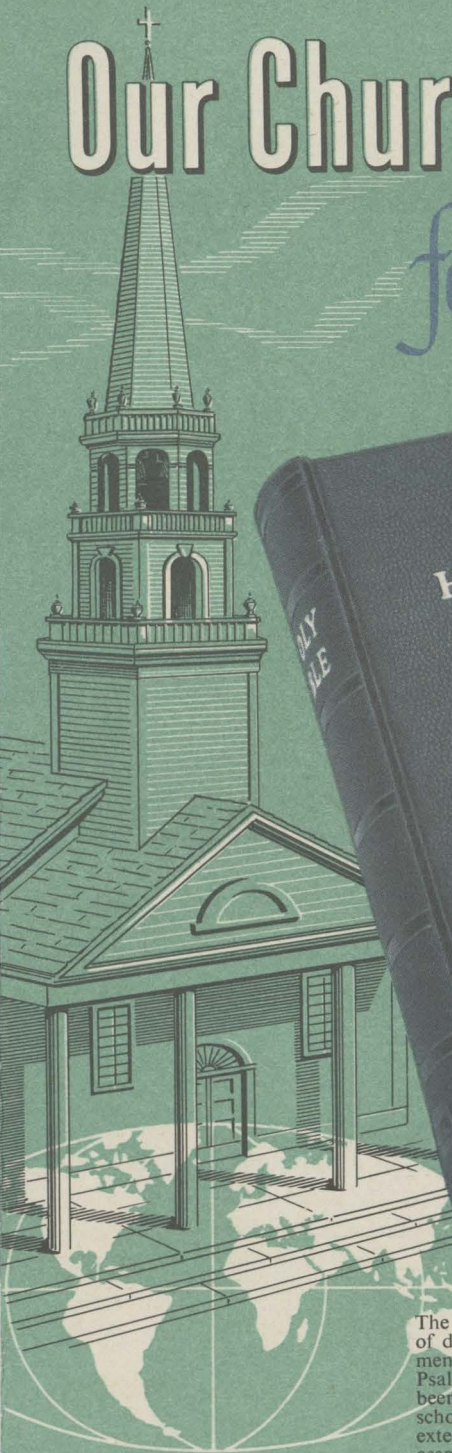


# Our Church Bulletin
