HYMN FOR THE MONTH

"All Beautiful the March of Days"

Like the stars of the heaven, the descent of snowflakes suggest infinity and reveal the superb artistry of the Creator. The Bible links it up with the abundant grace of God, and the Psalmist prayed "Wash me, and I will be whiter than snow." In this hymn, Frances Whitmarsh Wile, the author links the snow-clad landscape with the hearth and with the Creator. Mrs. Wile wrote this winter hymn at the request of her Minister, Dr. Wm. C. Gannett who was busy revising and publishing 'Unity Hymns and Carols' in 1910 and 11. The poem has appeared in many American hymnbooks, but set to various tunes. This tune 'Forrest Green' is actually an old English folk tune called 'The Ploughboy's Dream.'
