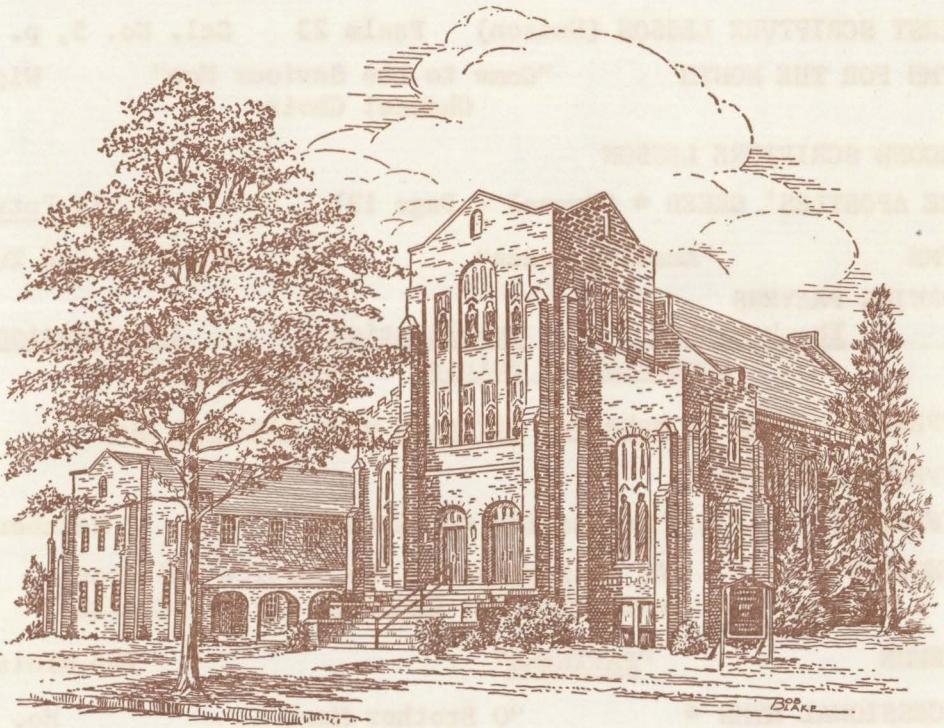

HYMN FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER

"Come to the Saviour Now" No. 261

Although written by John M. Wigner, son of an English Baptist minister, in 1871, this hymn did not appear in print until 1880, when it was included in the 'Supplement' of the English Baptist Psalms and Hymns, compiled by the author's father, who also edited the original edition of this Hymnal in 1858. The tune is called 'Invitation' and is the second hymn tune to be called by that name. Composed by Frederick Maker, it has the distinction of having been in the very first English Hymnal to be published where the music accompanied the words as we see them today.
