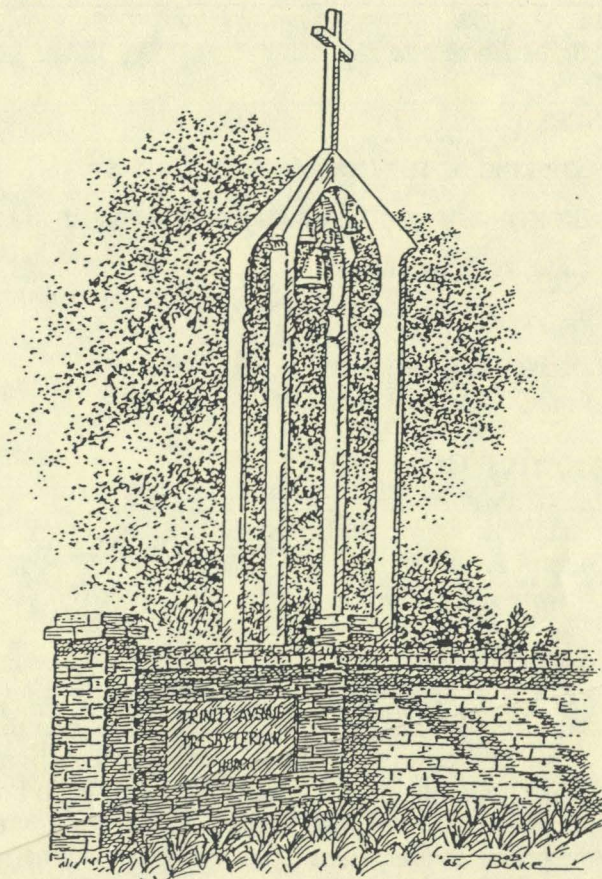
Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
