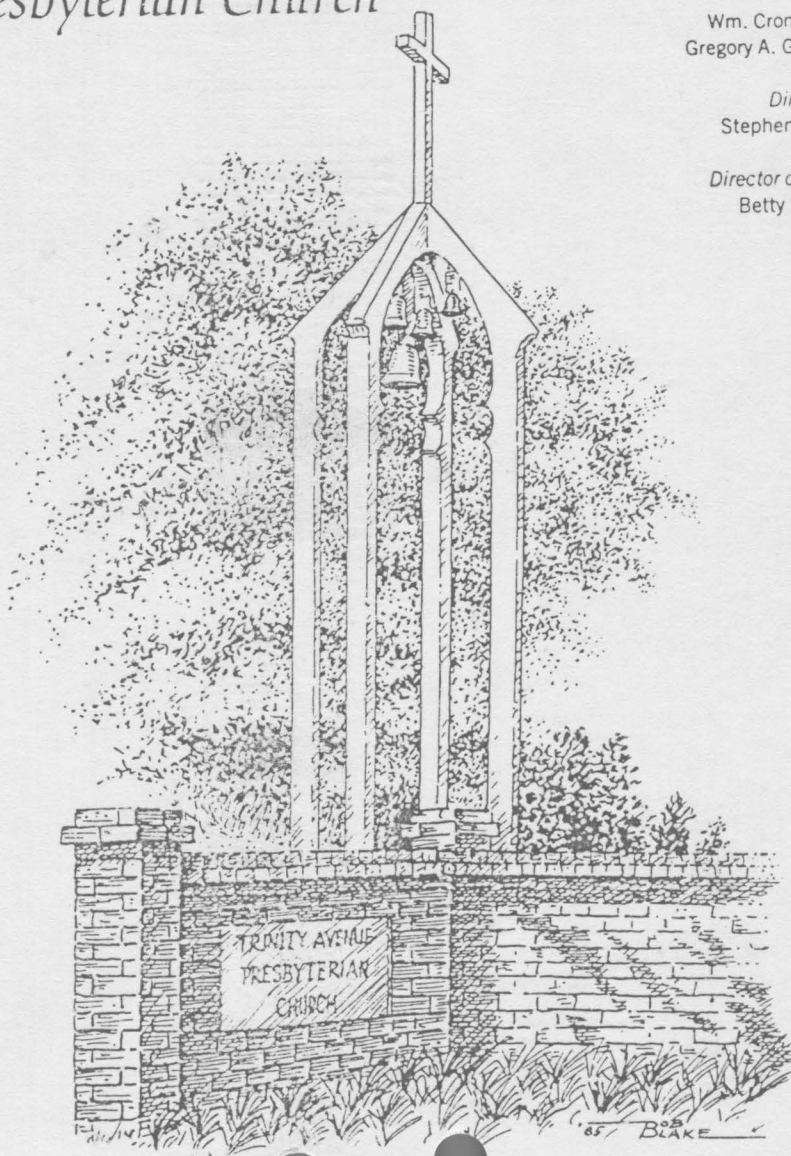

APPROACH (unison)
