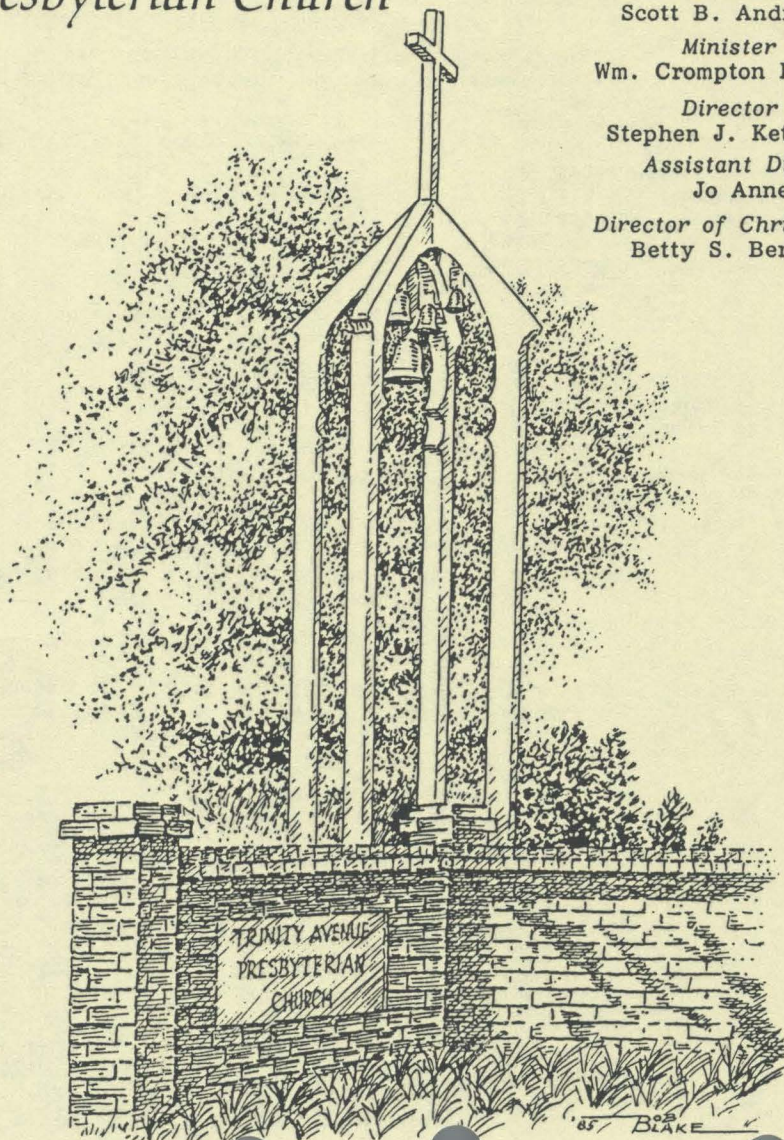
## PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING (unison)
