The Finance Committee met in the library of Duke Memorial United Methodist Church on Tuesday, October 30, 1979 At 7:30 P. M. with the chairman, W. T. Coman, presiding.

~~The chairman~~ The chairman opened the meeting with prayer.

Jane Lynch has been hired for 90 days. Since \$500.00 was left over from 1979 budget, she has been hired for \$1,187.50 for the remainder of the year as director and organist.

N. B. Fagan moved that her salary be added to the budget as it was presented to the Administrative Board. Seconded and passed. The correction to the budget adds Jane Lynch's salary \$8,995.00 for 1980. This amount includes insurance.

The minutes of the October 2 meeting were read by Anne Garrard, who had acted as secretary protem. The minutes were approved.

Shirley Few as chairman of the Every Member Commitment announced That approximately \$177,000.00 pledges had been turned in as of this meeting. It was suggested that a follow-up ~~letter~~ be done by telephone to complete the people not reached before. Cards were distributed to the members of the committee present for the calling. With the addition of the salary for Jane Lynch the budget figure will be approximately \$211,000.00.

M. T. Spears moved that a letter be sent to those who have already pledged asking them to increase their giving. Motion seconded and passed.

Meeting adjourned with Tom Coble's prayer at 8:33.
