Following prayer by the pastor, minutes of the last meeting which was held on May 24, 1967 were read, and, upon motion, approved.

Acting on a suggestion which was presented at an earlier meeting, the Commission, upon motion of Mr. White, seconded by Mr. Dunham and carried approved the omission of regular monthly meetings during the months of July and August. It was understood and agreed, however, that in the event a situation requiring the attention of the Commission might arise during those two months, a special meeting would be called.

The pastor then called to the attention of those present the fact that the present addressograph equipment used by the church office needed replacement. He further stated that a new Elliott system could be purchased for approximately \$950.00. After discussion, a motion was offered by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Clark and approved by the Commission that the pastor be empowered to purchase such equipment. It was not determined, however, whether the Memorial Fund would be asked to pay for the system or whether it would be charged to office expense, since the item was not included in the budget for the current year.

The pastor acknowledged to the Commission the fact that Mr. Dillard Teer had donated shrubbery in front of the church, and it was suggested that the Chairman write him a letter expressing our thanks.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned after prayer by the pastor.
