A meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Duke Memorial Methodist Church was held in the Church parlor 4:00 P.M., April 8, 1958. The following members were present:

Mr. Jordan stated that the purpose of this meeting was to give further consideration to the request of the City of Durham to acquire 17 feet of land on the west side of Duke Street, running from Chapel Hill Street to Memorial Street. Said land to be used by the City for the purpose of widening Duke Street. Mr. Jordan stated that the City had offered us \$16,200 to pay for the value of the land plus whatever additional damage the Church would suffer. Mr. Jordan, also stated that he had been advised by Mr. John Andrea, City Engineer, that the City Attorney had ruled informally that the City did not have the right to assess any part of the cost of widening Duke Street against the Church. The matter was discussed by various members present. A motion was made by Mr. Coman that we defer action on the City's request until we could secure further information. That is that we should have the land involved appraised by someone representing the Church, and that we also have a landscape architect submit a sketch showing the proper manner of repairing the damages caused by the loss of the land, and then submit an estimate of the cost of making such repairs. This motion was seconded by Mr. Fowler and carried by unanimous vote.
