

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

DUKE MEMORIAL METHODIST CHURCH

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Duke Memorial Methodist Church was held in the office of Mr. Marshall T. Spears on February 27, 1950 at 4:40 p.m. The following members were present:

The board dispensed with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to pass on the question of selling or disposing of our old parsonage. The secretary reported that he had two bids for the old building. One bid, received from Mr. George P. Whitley, was for \$350. His proposal covered the removal of the building only. Filling of the basement and leveling of the ground would not be included in his contract. The other bid was from Cole & Crumpacker. They bid \$300 for the building, which included filling the basement and leveling the ground. These two bids were discussed, following which a motion was made by C. J. Jones that the board accept the bid made by Cole & Crumpacker and authorize Marshall T. Spears to draw a proper contract to be signed by the chairman and secretary of the board and by Cole & Crumpacker. This motion was seconded by Mr. Spears and carried by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Spears then made a motion that the \$300 received from the sale of the old parsonage be paid on the parsonage debt which we owe to the Methodist Retirement Fund. This motion was seconded by C. J. Jones and carried.
