Hospitality Walk-Through March 17, 2009

Most young adults work in newer buildings with modern lighting, contemporary colors and textures, and fire security systems that make them feel safe. They are accustomed to quality and cleanliness in restrooms, and they come with high expectations about the safety of the nursery and classrooms for their children. Point out everything that could be improved!
