Hi Ginger,

I am emailing my thoughts. I am not faxing a sketch.

I agree that the awning should be the same color as the one at the Soul Cafe. I am affraid that the black metal design over the awning will be very busy because the colors will be contrasting. I think the metal design should be dropped off. Also consider this. What if the shape of the awning was the same arch design as the Soul Cafe awning. This would keep the two back entrances looking the same. They would look like they were planned together instead of two separate projects. On the front of this one simply have a cross in white outlined in black and below it WELCOME in the same white outlined in black. Put this centered just as Soul Cafe logo is. Widen the side walk the same all the way to the street. It will be approx. the same width as the cross walk. There is already a Duke Memorial sign on the building to the right.

Is the committee designing the side walk concerned about the water that comes off awning on building side and where it will go? Will it hurt windows or collect on new walk causing a slippery mess? Does cost change with awning design changes? Just thoughts,
