

PALM SUNDAY, APRIL 8, 1979

1. Lee Ona Phillips had a beautiful arrangement of Azaleas in Narthex.
2. Friday, April 6.:
 - a. Put cardboard mats in middle of large plastic circles.
 - b. Set Palms on mats and drew plastic up around pots and taped securely.
 - c. Set Palms in middle of foil squares (saved from last year), and pleated around pots. Tucked foil into top of pots to hold it, and fluted to look as nice as possible.
 - d. Put Palms on a kitchen cart and rolled to Sanctuary.
3. In Sanctuary:
 - a. Placed smallest Palm on Chancel Rail left of Font - just enough so that Palm branches did not hang over end of Chancel Rail (to interfere with people coming through the doors).
 - b. Placed largest Palm on the other side so that branches did not hang over end of Chancel Rail.
1. Palm Sunday April 8.:
 - a. Flowers in Urns on Pedestals as usual.
 - b. Two bud vases with Rosebuds placed on side near largest Palm.
2.
 - a. Acolytes lighted candles as usual.
 - b. Children's Choirs carrying Palm Branches led Processional from Narthex, followed by Senior Choir, then Ministers.

After Service:

- a. Brought kitchen cart to Sanctuary and took Palms back to Whitford Hall.
- b. Removed foil, liners, and pads.
- c. Rolled foil and liners on tube for future use.
